
What Is Different?

KEY PASSAGE: Ephesians 2:8

BIG PICTURE QUESTION:

 Why did Jesus die on the cross? Jesus died on the cross to save us from our sins, and He is alive today.

BIBLE STORY: JESUS' RESURRECTION

- Mary saw Jesus' body was gone from the tomb.
- Peter and John looked inside the empty tomb.
- Mary saw and talked to Jesus.
- Jesus is alive!

- What would you have thought or done if you were Mary? Peter or John?
- Why did the religious leaders want the soldiers to lie and say Jesus' body had been stolen?
- Why is Jesus' coming back to life so important?
