
Find the Bibles

BIBLE STORY: JESUS APPEARED TO THE DISCIPLES


- Jesus' friends locked themselves in a house because they were afraid after Jesus died.

FAMILY ACTIVITY:

• Throw a "Jesus Is Alive" family dance party. Laugh, dance, and sing songs to celebrate Jesus' resurrection. Say the disciples were so happy to see Jesus.

FAMILY ACTIVITY:


 Think about a relative or friend whom your family has not seen in a long time. Send a card, make a phone call, or plan a visit to reconnect.

BIBLE STORY: JESUS FORGIVES AND RESTORES


- Jesus' friends went fishing.

FAMILY ACTIVITY:


- Go fishing as a family or pretend to fish using a dowel with a magnet and paper clips attached to paper fish. Review the Bible story as you fish.

FAMILY ACTIVITY:


 Make a prayer calendar of people or people groups you can pray for. Keep the prayer calendar in your vehicle and pray at stoplights.

FAMILY ACTIVITY:


- Look at maps. Identify your town, your state, your nation, and other nations in the world.
