<p><b>1. Salvation</b> Lord, let salvation spring up within my children, that they may obtain the salvation that is in Christ Jesus, with eternal glory. <i>Isaiah 45:8, 2 Timothy 2:1, John 3:16</i></p>	<p><b>2. Grace</b> I pray that they may "grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ". <i>2 Peter 3:18, 2 Corinthians 13:14</i></p>	<p><b>3. Love</b> Grant Lord that my children may learn to live a life of love through the Spirit who dwells in them. <i>Ephesians 5:2, Galatians 5:22, 1 John 3:1</i></p>	<p><b>4. Honesty/Integrity</b> May integrity and honesty be their virtue and their protection. <i>Psalms 25:21, Proverbs 10:9</i></p>	<p><b>5. Self-control</b> Father, help my children not to be like many others around them, but let them "be alert and self-controlled" in all they do. <i>1 Thessalonians 5:6, 2 Timothy 1:7</i></p>	<p><b>6. Love for God's Word</b> May my children grow to find Your Word "more precious than gold, than much pure gold; [and] sweeter than honey, than honey from the comb." <i>Psalms 19:10</i></p>	<p><b>7. Justice</b> God, help my children to love justice as You do and to "act justly" in all they do. <i>Psalms 11:7, Micah 6:8</i></p>
<p><b>8. Mercy</b> May my children always "be merciful, as [their] Father is merciful." <i>Luke 6:36, James 5:11</i></p>	<p><b>9. Respect</b> Father, grant that my children may "show proper respect to everyone," as Your Word commands. <i>1 Peter 2:17</i></p>	<p><b>10. Biblical Self-Esteem</b> Help my children develop a strong self-esteem that is rooted in the realization that they are "God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus." <i>Ephesians 2:10</i></p>	<p><b>11. Faithfulness</b> "Let love and faithfulness never leave [my children]," but bind these twin virtues around their necks and write them on the tablet of their hearts. <i>Proverbs 3:3, 1 Samuel 12:24</i></p>	<p><b>12. A Passion for God</b> Lord, please instill in my children a soul with a craving for You, a heart that clings passionately to You. <i>Psalms 63:8</i></p>	<p><b>13. Responsibility</b> Grant that my children may learn responsibility, "for each one should carry his own load." <i>Galatians 6:5</i></p>	<p><b>14. Kindness</b> Lord, may my children "always try to be kind to each other and to everyone else." <i>1 Thessalonians 5:15, Ephesians 4:32</i></p>
<p><b>15. Generosity</b> Grant that my children may "be generous and willing to share [and so] lay up treasures for themselves as a firm foundation for the coming age." <i>1 Timothy 6:18-19</i></p>	<p><b>16. Peace</b> Father, let my children "make every effort to do what leads to peace." <i>Romans 14:19, Isaiah 26:3</i></p>	<p><b>17. Hope</b> May the God of hope grant that my children may overflow with hope and hopefulness by the power of the Holy Spirit. <i>Romans 15:13, Isaiah 40:31</i></p>	<p><b>18. Perseverance</b> Lord, teach my children perseverance in all they do, and help them especially to "run with perseverance the race marked out for [them]". <i>Hebrews 12:1</i></p>	<p><b>19. Humility</b> Lord, please cultivate in my children the ability to "show true humility towards all." <i>Titus 3:2, Philippians 2:3-4</i></p>	<p><b>20. Compassion</b> Lord, please clothe my children with the virtue of compassion. <i>Colossians 3:12</i></p>	<p><b>21. Prayerfulness</b> Grant, Lord, that my children's lives may be marked by prayerfulness that they may learn to "pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests." <i>Ephesians 6:18</i></p>
<p><b>22. Contentment</b> Father, teach my children "the secret of being content in any and every situation... through Him who gives [them] strength." And to be content with what they have. <i>Philippians 4:12-13, Hebrews 13:5</i></p>	<p><b>23. Faith</b> I pray that faith will find root and grow in my children's hearts; that by faith, they may gain what has been promised to them. <i>Luke 17:5-6, Hebrews 11:1-4</i></p>	<p><b>24. A Servant Heart</b> Lord, please help my children develop servant hearts; that they may serve wholeheartedly "as if [they] were serving the Lord, not men." <i>Ephesians 6:7, Galatians 5:13</i></p>	<p><b>25. Purity</b> "Create in [them] a pure heart, O God," and let their purity of heart be shown in their actions. <i>Psalms 51:10, Psalms 119:9</i></p>	<p><b>26. A Willingness and Ability to Work Hard</b> Teach my children, Lord, to value work and to work hard at everything they do. <i>Ecclesiastes 9:10</i></p>	<p><b>27. Self-discipline</b> Father, I pray that my children may develop self-discipline; that they may acquire "a disciplined and prudent life, doing what is right and just and fair." <i>Proverbs 1:3</i></p>	<p><b>28. Thankfulness/Gratitude</b> Lord, please fill my children with a heart of thankfulness for you, all you have given them and all you have done for them. <i>Colossians 3:17, Ephesians 5:20</i></p>
<p><b>29. Joy</b> May my children be filled "with the joy given by the Holy Spirit." <i>1 Thessalonians 1:6, Nehemiah 8:10</i></p>	<p><b>30. Courage</b> May my children always "be strong and courageous" in their character and their actions. <i>Deuteronomy 31:6, Joshua 1:9</i></p>	<p><b>31. Trust</b> May my children always trust in you Lord and submit to your authority in all areas of their life. Help to keep them straight on your path. <i>Proverbs 3:5-6</i></p>	<p>Using this calendar will help you to pray thirty-one different biblical virtues over your children. Use it as a guide each month, combining some of the traits for months, which do not have 31 days.
