#2 "AGREEING WITH GOD"

Proverbs 18:21 (Amp) Death and life are in the power of the tongue, And those who love it and indulge it will eat its fruit and bear the consequences of their words.

- ▶ Work is more powerful and productive when people work together in agreement.

Philippians 4:2-3 (TPT) I urge Euodia and I urge Syntyche to agree and to work in harmony in the Lord. Indeed, I ask you too, my true companion, to help these women [to keep on cooperating], for they have shared my struggle in the [cause of the] gospel, together with Clement and the rest of my fellow workers, whose names are in the Book of Life.

- ▶ Relationships are more powerful, enjoyable and fulfilling when people are in harmony and agreement.

Ecclesiastes 4:9 (TLB) Two can accomplish more than twice as much as one, for the results can be much better.

- ▶ Prayer is more powerful and fruitful when it's offered in agreement.

Matthew 18:19-20 (TPT) Again, I give you an eternal truth: If two of you agree to ask God for something in a symphony of prayer, my heavenly Father will do it for you. For wherever two or three come together in honor of my name, I am right there with them!"

- ▶ Your life is more powerful and productive when you are undivided in thought, motives, etc.

2 Corinthians 11:3 (NLT) But I fear that somehow your pure and undivided devotion to Christ will be corrupted, just as Eve was deceived by the cunning ways of the serpent.

Psalms 86:11 (NIV) Teach me your way, Lord, that I may rely on your faithfulness; give me an undivided heart, that I may fear your name.

- ▶ Your relationship and walk with God are more powerful, peaceful and fruitful when you are in agreement with Him.

Amos 3:3 (NKJV) Can two walk together, unless they are agreed?
